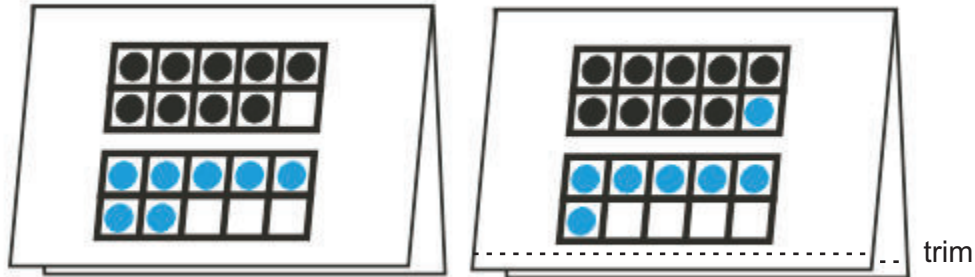


Every two pages go together - they show an addition fact on two ten frames, and then again after dots have been moved to fill the first ten frame.

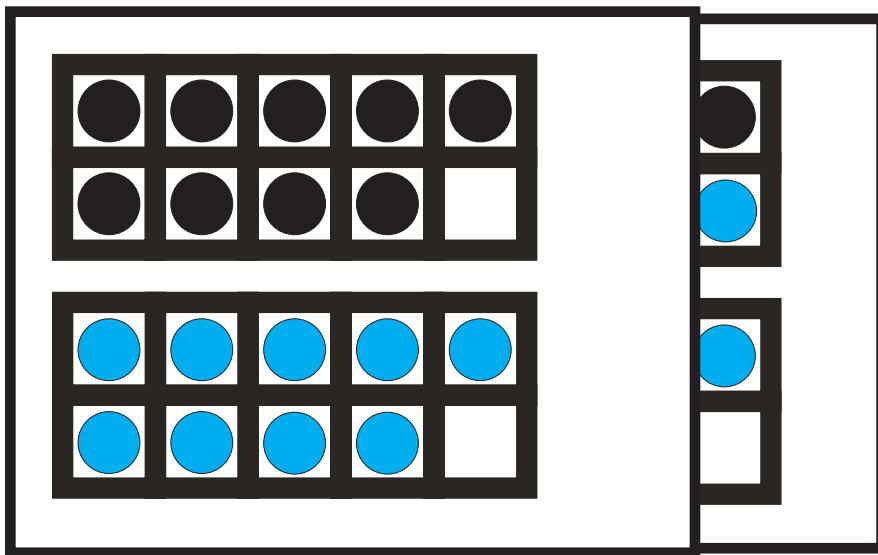
Take two pages that go together and fold them the page in half, dots out.



The second page, that shows the dot moved, needs to be trimmed slightly.

Tape each page together across the bottom with clear tape.

The second page should now slide inside the first.



The outside will show the fact before the dot is moved, the inside after. The inside should provide a good visual reference to the total as a ten is clearly visible. Work with these cards should follow extensive work with teen numbers on ten frames.

The grey dots can be left as is, or covered with 5/8" colour dots available from the dollar store.
